Eco-Schools Topic	Waste/Biodiversity
Aim	-Reduce the amount of waste found in our school grounds. -Reduce the amount of waste in the lunch hall. -Recycle more things like batteries and pens. -Help recycle and reuse more items. -Encourage more wildlife in our school grounds.
Action(s)	- Start litter picking club. - Organise a community litter pick. - Start a recycling point in school to help recycle pens, paper, batteries and other items. - Work with PTA to support the second-hand clothes shop. Encourage clothes donations. - Encourage food waste recycling across the school. - Update bin labels to encourage recycling. - Set up new recycling/upcycling bins. - Look into organising an upcycling club. - Re-use items to create bug houses. - Bring and Borrow Book sharing sessions - donate spare books to the book shelter or for eco-themed activities. - Use more recycled paper. - Make bird houses and bird feeders. -Develop an area for wild flowers to grow. -Organise key events to celebrate diversity. -Take part in any global or national campaigns like World Earth Day. -Write to our MP about our environmental work.
Informing & Involving	-We will create posters and Eco News bulletins to let the school community know what we are planning to do. Aim	-Raise everyone's awareness of how to care for our oceans. -Reduce plastic waste. -Discourage the use of single use plastics. -Organise a whole school bottle/bottle top project to raise awareness of the importance of recycling plastic.
Action(s)	-Organise theme days linked to marine objectives. -Share facts with the school community about plastic waste and pollution in the oceans. -Reduce the amount of glitter ordered/used. -Speak to PTA about use more eco-friendly products. -Reduce laminating across the school. -Raise awareness of the use of single use plastic - arrange plastic free events. -Audit use of single use plastics. -Encourage plastic free lunches.
Informing & Involving	- Hold a collective worship each term to update the school community. - Contact the local council and the School Street Scheme. - Promote an awareness of how to make school community a safer place to be. -We will create posters and Eco-News bulletins to let the school community know what we are planning to do. We will add information about plastic pollution. -We will lead a Collective Worship about our aims and ideas. Class Reps will be asked to help by sharing ideas and suggestions with their friends.
