You can book as many meals as your child requires for the week. You can, of course, book as many weeks in advance as you wish. Please note that this is the only facility for booking school meals.

School Attendance

Now our wonderful reception pupils are settled and are in full time, we will be monitoring attendance in the school.

Parents are responsible for making sure their children attend school regularly and on time. We actively encourage parents to make health and dental appointments outside of school hours to reduce disruption to learning. We do however recognise that medical appointments issued by healthcare professional occur in school hours and as such, will be authorised accordingly. We also understand that children will be unwell from time to time, and we do not encourage poorly children to attend school.

Every week we hold a celebration assembly with the children and have been able to celebrate the attendance of the children and the classes that achieve the highest attendance for the previous week. The whole school target is 100%. School attendance is obligatory for children in the UK between the ages of five and sixteen.




