# **END OF TERM NEWSLETTER - DECEMBER 2023**

Dear Parents and Carers,

What a truly wonderful few weeks we have had here at school. We have enjoyed a delicious feast, cooked by the wonderful kitchen staff, we've had a Santa dash, we've had a Christmas Fayre as well as an abundance of productions performed by our fabulous children.

This time is always busy but this week we had the added excitement of a main road closure that led to increased traffic passing our school. What parents don't see is: the telephone calls between staff over the weekend; the calls to Highways and the Police, to request assistance, to keep the children safe; the super early starts to check the conditions of the roads and pathways that our families walk and the last-minute changes of plans that invariably make things a little harder for a short time – but always worth it! I'm sure I speak on behalf of all the parents of Tutshill, when I thank the teachers for all that they do, to keep school life ticking over as smoothly as possibly!

This week, we requested that more parents walk to school or park further afield, due to increased traffic. It has been noticed by not only the school staff and local residents but by many parents, how much easier and safer their walk to school has been due to the reduced number of cars parked at school. Please can I ask parents, that wherever possible, you walk to school. The Eco-Council want to take this project on and really push this initiative forward in the new year. We will also be conversing with Highways to see if we can request further road traffic control/measures, including road markings, to keep our roads safe.

I must also request that parents who drive to school consider local residents' property, as well as the safety of the pupils. Sadly, I saw a number of parents swing into private driveways and then proceed to turn in the road right next to Rob, our crossing patrol. This is not safe, and I urge parents to reconsider their movements.

We have arrived at the end of an exceptionally long term, yet the children have been truly wonderful! The Chairs of the Governing Board came into see the pupils on the 12<sup>th</sup> December and they were impressed with how the children behave, how they spoke to one another and how the children engaged in conversation with them. The Chairs were able to report this at the Governors meeting held at the end of term. The Governing Board has three new members: Mrs Cheryl Bray (Parent Governor), Mr Dominic Broad (Co-opted Governor) and Mr Simon Hardy (Co-opted Governor). The Governing Board will present their annual report early next year and will be planning an event for both School's in the federation to attend to hear all the successes of the federation thus far.
