This week we have been learning about Parliament's role in making laws and shaping society. We have explored the different activities that take place in the Houses of Parliament and discussed the various people who work there.


We also found out how everyone can get involved in democracy and discovered how we can contact our local MP to share our ideas and thoughts.

#### Attendance

We have been closely monitoring attendance throughout Term 2 to ensure every child has the best opportunity to learn and thrive. Good attendance is essential for academic progress and wellbeing, and we are pleased to see strong figures across the school, with overall attendance at 96%. Reception and Year 1 have led the way with attendance above 97%, which is fantastic! However, we have recorded 278 late marks this term, and we kindly remind families that punctuality is just as important as attendance. Thank you for your continued support in helping us maintain high standards and ensuring children arrive on time, ready to learn. Please note that the school register is taken between 8:45am and 9:15am each day. It is important that children arrive promptly so they can settle into their learning and avoid being marked late.
