Please ensure your child is wearing the correct coloured uniform for both school days and PE days.

Our school uniform remains unchanged and consists of:

- A light blue polo shirt.
- School sweatshirt or navy jumper or cardigan, plain or with school logo only.

- Grey socks/tights
- Dark coloured appropriate sensible shoes, no trainers or multi coloured shoes. All black court shoe trainers are acceptable.

- Navy or dark coloured hair bobbles

PE Kit:

- Navy T-shirt and navy shorts
- Navy jogging trousers/leggings and jumper/sweatshirt, plain or with the school logo.
- KS1 (Reception, Y1 and Y2) daps/black or white trainers.
- KS2 (Y3, 4, 5 and 6) daps/black or white trainers (no colour/logos/names).

Uniform does not have to have the school logo on.
