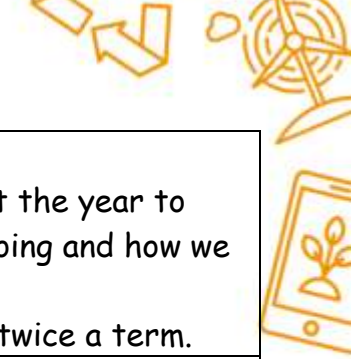


Action Plan

Ask them to ask their classes for any ideas they may have. <p>Summer Term:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Encourage teachers to raise awareness about saving water and investigate lesson ideas.- Build a new hedgehog home.

Aim	<p>To reduce litter in our school grounds and in the local community.</p> <p>To raise awareness of the importance of keeping our community clean.</p> <p>To promote recycling and reusing.</p>
Action(s)	<p>Autumn Term:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Re-introduce a litter picking club. - Relaunch the crisp packet campaign. - Promote less waste with clothing by asking for donations of coats, hats, scarves, gloves and sleeping bags to give to the homeless. - Work out how many bins we have and check that we have recycling bins. - Label bins correctly. - Re-launch the importance of recycling. - Appoint litter monitors. <p>Spring Term:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Organise a litter pick in the community. - Take part in the 'Keep Britain Tidy Great Big School Clean'. <p>Summer Term:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Organise a litter focussed project linked to recycling and reusing things. <p>Ongoing:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Organise and lead Collective Worship throughout the year to inform the school community about what we are doing and how we are getting on. - Create Eco-News Bulletins for the whole school twice a term.

Eco-Schools Topic	Transport
Aim	<p>To make our School Community a safer place.</p> <p>To introduce the School Street scheme or something similar to our school community.</p>
Action(s)	<p>Autumn Term:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Carry out a survey to see how children travel to school. <p>Spring Term:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Organise a walk to school day/week. -Look into setting up a park and stride or a walking bus to encourage children to walk to school instead of driving. -Contact the local council to ask about crossing patrols and about our school becoming a 'School Street'. Contact the School Street website to find out more. - Develop a 'No Idling policy' an inform our school community through posters and information leaflets. -Carry out a traffic survey to see how many vehicles go past our school. -Identify where the school community travel from to get to and from school. <p>Summer Term:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Promote travelling to school in different ways.
Informing & Involving	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Hold a collective worship each term to update the school community. -Contact the local council and the School Street Scheme. - Promote an awareness of how to make school community a safer place to be.
Monitoring & Evaluation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Carry out a traffic survey and discuss results. -Carry out a survey about transport and discuss results. -Monitor how the school community change as we introduce our changes.
