REMINDERS...

- **URGENT Year 6 - Residential payment. Any payments due need to be made asap.**
- Payments School lunch bookings . Please ensure your child's school meal is booked in advance of the day, preferably a week ahead.
- As we move into the summer term, we would be grateful for your support in providing your child with a sun-hat and sun-cream for use in school. The children will need to administer the sun-cream themselves. Please also ensure that your child has a water bottle in school for use with water only.
- If your child suffers from hay fever, please inform school by completing one of our "Healthcare Plan for a Pupil with Medical Needs" forms (which can be collected from the school office) and confirm whether your child should be kept indoors at play-time and lunch-time. All children will be sent out to play on our main field, weather permitting, unless we receive your confirmation that they are to be kept

indoors for supervised play. There is not an option of being kept on the playground if the school is on the field, due to the number of staff that we have. The school's usual administration of medication policy applies to hay fever remedies. We can only administer prescribed medication with its original pharmacist's dispensing label (specific to the child) complete with dosage instructions. Please visit the school office to collect a form if appropriate.

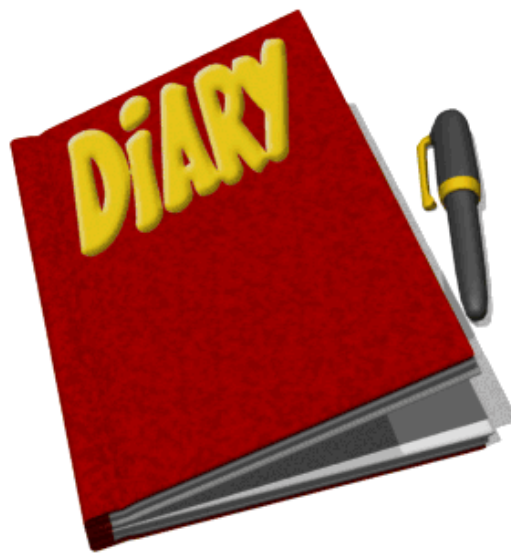

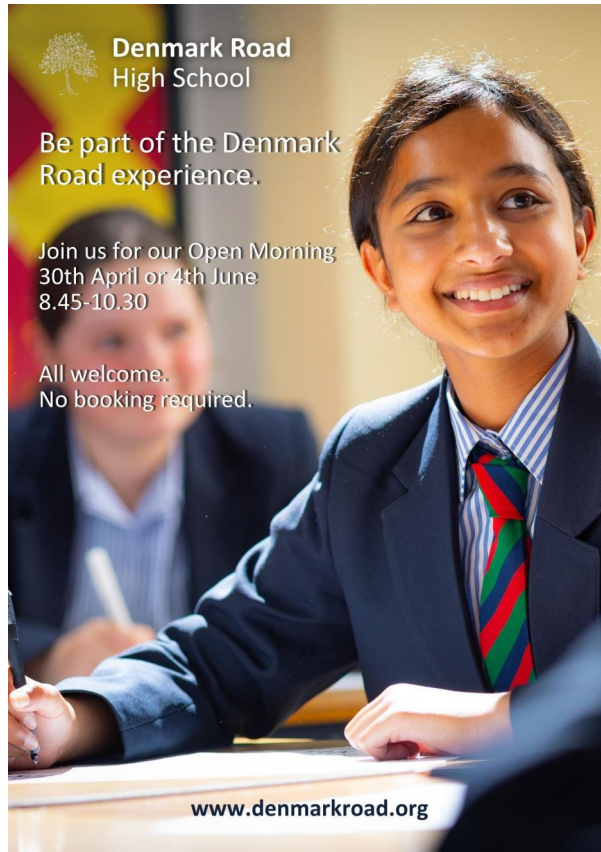
