

INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT

1. The name of the federation is: **Forest Edge Federation**
2. The names and categories of the schools in the federation are:

Name	Category
Tutshill Church of England Primary School	Voluntary Controlled
Woolaston Primary School	Community
3. The name of the governing body is '**The governing body of Forest Edge Federation**'
4. The governing body shall consist of:
 - 2 parent governors
 - 1 LA governor
 - 1 staff governor
 - 1 headteacher
 - 2 foundation governors
 - 5 co-opted governors
5. Total number of governors: **12**
6. Foundation governors shall be appointed by Gloucester Diocesan Board of Education after consultation with the Tidenham Parochial Church Council.
7.
 - (a) The holder of the following office shall be a foundation governor ex officio:

The principal officiating minister of the ecclesiastical parish of Tidenham.
 - (b) The Archdeacon of the Archdeaconry in which the school is situated shall, on behalf of Gloucester Diocesan Board of Education, be entitled to appoint a foundation governor to act in the place of an ex officio foundation governor whose governorship derives from the office named in (a) above, in the event that that ex officio foundation governor is unable or unwilling to act as a foundation governor, or there is a vacancy in the office by virtue of which the governorship exists, or has been removed from office under regulation 21(1) of the Regulations.

8. The Archdeacon of the Archdeaconry in which the school is situated shall, on behalf of Gloucester Diocesan Board of Education, be entitled to request the removal of any ex officio foundation governor and to appoint any substitute governor.
9. A Trust exists which relates to Tutshill Church of England Primary School, the Trustees being Gloucester Diocesan Board of Education.
10. Our schools, each with their own unique character, will work together in a strong, supportive, resilient structure to provide high-quality education for our children and to be an asset to our local communities.
11. This instrument comes into effect on 20th June 2022.
12. This instrument was made by order of Gloucestershire County Council
on 14th June 2022
13. A copy of the instrument must be supplied free of charge to every member and associate member of the governing body (and the headteacher if not a governor), as well as, where relevant, the trustees of any foundation, the appropriate diocesan authority and appropriate religious body.
